Communications Technician Series
Classification/Examination Meeting

The following topic is presented for your consideration. It will be briefly discussed during the upcoming conference call for this group of classifications.

- Proposed MAQ:
Below are the proposed formatting changes for the Communications Technician Series MAQ's. Please provide feedback during the scheduled meeting as to how these changes would clarify the intended application or use of the proposed MAQ.

Level I: Communications Technician I 3901

Any combination totaling **9 months** from the following categories:

- (a) college/vocational/technical training in telecommunications, electronics engineering/technology, data processing, or a related technical field
 - 30 semester hours equals 9 months
- (b) work experience in the installation, maintenance, and/or repair of communications, electronic, and/or data processing equipment

Level II: Communications Technician II 3902

1. Any combination totaling **18 months** from the following categories:

- (a) college/vocational/technical training in telecommunications, electronics engineering/technology, data processing, or a related technical field
 - 30 semester hours equals 9 months
 - 60 semester hours equals 18 months
- (b) work experience in communications comparable to that gained as a Communications Technician I

2. As required by the employing institution, possession of a valid driver's license as required by the State of Illinois for the type of motor vehicle(s) to be operated by the incumbent

Level III: Communications Technician III 3903

1. Any combination totaling **18 months** from the following categories:
 - (a) college/vocational/technical training in telecommunications, electronics engineering/technology, data processing, or a related technical field
 - 30 semester hours equals 9 months
 - 60 semester hours equals 18 months
 - (b) work experience in communications comparable to that gained as a Communications Technician II
2. **24 months** additional work experience in communications comparable to that gained as a Communications Technician II
3. As required by the employing institution, possession of a valid driver's license as required by the State of Illinois for the type of motor vehicle(s) to be operated by the incumbent
