RE: Proposal Notice: **Electroencephalographic Series**

A. Purpose

The State Universities Civil Service System (University System) continues to revise and modify its classification plan. The overall objective is to provide a structured and consistent classification and examination system that provides employment within the University System on the basis of merit and fitness.

The Electroencephalographic classification series has been identified for revision, to include the following classifications:

- 1. Electroencephalographic Technician (Class Code Number 3945)**
- 2. Electroencephalographic Specialist (Class Code Number 3950)**
- 3. Electroencephalographic Supervisor (Class Code Number 3955)**

B. Next Steps

Once the draft specification and examination have been developed, the University System will conduct a series of meetings to review the proposed specification and examination and provide an opportunity for feedback. We will provide a meeting announcement at a later date.
