SUBJECT: **Preliminary Status: Deletion of Furniture Restoration Supervisor Classification (Class Code 1676)**

DATE: July 31, 2026

- A. Purpose: The State Universities Civil Service System (University System) continues to revise and modify its classification plan. The overall objective is to provide an effective classification and examination system that meets the business requirements of the University System. Class plan maintenance includes deleting unused classifications and combining similar classifications.
- B. Action Proposed: The following classification is proposed for deletion from the State Universities Civil Service System Classification Plan, effective **Monday, September 14, 2026:**
Furniture Restoration Supervisor Classification (Class Code 1676)
