Stage 1 – Police Sergeant Knowledge Test equals 35% of total examination score. There are 74 multiple choice questions (5 experimental, not counted in score). You must achieve a score of 70 (48 correct answers) or above to pass this stage and to be eligible to take Stage 2 (Structured Oral Board).
Stage 2 – Police Sergeant Structured Oral Board Examination equals 65% of total examination score. There are 3 exercises. You must achieve a score of 70 (score of 46) or above to pass this stage and to pass the examination. Your total final ratings from the 3 exercises are converted to a score which must be a score of 70 or above.
Scores from Stages 1 and 2 are totaled to achieve your final examination/register score. Failure to receive a passing score of 70 for <i>both</i> stages of the Police Sergeant examination will result in a failing examination score. Therefore, it is possible for an applicant to receive a final examination score of 70 or above and fail the examination due to an applicant not receiving a passing score of 70 for either part of the examination, Stage 1 and/or 2. You failed the Structured Oral Board.
